<p>Classroom Procedure:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Introduce vocabulary orally . Have students repeat as a class. 2. Write on the top of the board "Proper behavior with my child" Improper behavior with my child." 3. Guide students to list proper and improper behaviors with children. List responses on the board under appropriate heading. 4. Read responses from the board and ask students to repeat. 5. Discuss legal consequences in this county for improper behavior toward a child. Advise students that "In the United States children under 18 have to go to school." And "In the United States children under twelve must always be supervised by an adult." 6.
